RESPONSE TO UGSC COMMENTS

There were two comments/questions that arose during the UGCS's review and approval process of the Social Sciences proposal:

1) CROSS-LISTING OTHER DEPARTMENT'S COURSES: There was some concern (albeit not fully explained) about the proposed cross-listing of several courses offered by other departments as PS and/or SOC courses. This aspect of the original proposal has been dropped.

2) TEACHING THE PROPOSED COURSES: The specializations were developed with normal departmental teaching schedules in mind. The list below of offerings over the three years between Fall 2005 and Summer 2008 (inclusive) demonstrates that the courses needed for the revised major are already part of our repertoire. The four new courses can all be taught by the incoming departmental chairperson. The department is currently searching for a tenure-track political scientist able to teach courses in the policy analysis and urban affairs specializations, and another search will be held next year. While it will thus be possible in future to provide an even richer array of courses, the restructured major is ready to go next semester.
