

PROPOSED ADDITION TO FACULTY HANDBOOK

Under VII. Responsibilities in Student-Faculty Relationships, add:

H. Teaching Children or Other Close Family Members

A faculty member should make every effort to avoid having in class a child, spouse or other person with whom the faculty member has a close, family-like relationship. If degree requirements make it imperative that the child, spouse or other close relative take a particular class from a faculty member, the faculty member should discuss the conflict with his or her academic unit head, and the academic unit head should determine whether the enrollment is appropriate.
